



***RECOGNITION OF OUTSTANDING STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT***

**COMPLIANCE WITH THIS PUBLICATION IS MANDATORY**

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**AUI 36-2303, 21 December 1995, is supplemented as follows:**

**2. Designation of Distinguished Graduate (DG).** Attendance at an Air Force school is challenging and beneficial both to the student and the Air Force. It is important to formally recognize students who attain a record of outstanding accomplishment through a Distinguished Graduate (DG) program and to permanently document such accomplishments.

2.1. In addition to academic achievement or performance skills rankings among the students, the “whole person” concept, based on professional qualities (e.g. character, integrity, leadership, followership, and team building) will be used.

2.1.1 (Added) Graduate Education. Criteria will include: Academic scores (GPA of 3.75 or higher), and recommendation of the department heads based on review of bearing, behavior and attitude to ensure the students who are ranked high are deserving of the honor associated with DG.

2.1.2 (Added) Professional Continuing Education (PCE). Criteria will include: Final grade of A, based on exams, written assignments, group projects/exercises where participation points are awarded based on students’ attitudes, sharing knowledge, skills and experience, and communication and performance skills (measurement of technical proficiency, and comprehension of technical materials) where applicable. Course length must be six weeks or longer.

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
