★17.2.1.1. (Added) Customer Service is responsible for the After Hours Support Function (AHSF). See Squadron Operating Instruction 23-1 for responsibilities and duties.

17.5.2. In order to receive real time manual training, do not use the MICAP Automated Sourcing System (MASS) during extended computer downtime. Use AFMAN 23-110, Volume II, Part Two, Chapter 32, for manual or AFMAN 23-110, Volume II, Part Eleven, for automated procedures.

★17.23.1. The Chief, Management and Systems Flight, may develop and use an AWP checklist for validating AWP requirements. If a checklist is not developed, accomplish all actions specified in the basic manual.

17.27.3. Awaiting parts (AWP) end items may be stored in the maintenance shops.
