AFI 31-207, 1 August 1999, is supplemented as follows:

This supplement establishes guidance and procedures for the Arming and Use of Force by Air Force personnel on Maxwell Air Force Base, Gunter Annex, and Maxwell Family Housing Annex. It applies to all military, civilian, and contract personnel as well as military personnel from other US military branches assigned or attached to Air Force units. Failure to observe the prohibitions and mandatory provisions of the supplement may result in administrative actions or other disciplinary measures. The Air Force may take administrative disciplinary action against civilian employees who violate these instructions.

1.3.4.3.2. (AETC) The Security Forces Commander (42 SFS/CC) has adopted the use of the collapsible baton for use at Maxwell AFB, Gunter Annex, and the Maxwell Family Housing Annex. Personnel who employ this level of force must have attended an approved training course.

1.3.4.3.3 (AETC) The Security Forces Commander (42 SFS/CC) has adopted the use of Oleoresin Capsicum (OC) pepper spray (Z-305 CAP-STUN pepper spray) for use at Maxwell AFB, Gunter Annex, and the Maxwell Family Housing Annex. Personnel who employ this level of force must have attended an approved training course.
