SUBJECT: 2017 Maxwell Air Force Base (AFB) Air Installation Compatible Use Zone
(AICUZ) Review

1. Maxwell AFB recently completed a review of the last AICUZ study dated September 2009. The mission of Maxwell AFB remains unchanged since this study was completed. Currently, C-130 aircraft are assigned to Maxwell AFB.
2. The purpose of the AICUZ program is to examine and evaluate aircraft noise and accident potential associated with the installation's flying mission. The resulting data is then used to develop local planning guidance that will ensure public safety and well-being as well as to preserve the operational capabilities of Maxwell AFB. In more specific terms, the report contains a description of the affected local area and discusses the locations and definitions of the runway clear zones, aircraft Accident Potential Zones, and noise contours. For property located in these areas it also provides a list of land uses deemed compatible with airfield operations.
3. We greatly value the positive relationship Maxwell AFB has experienced with its neighbors over the years. As Montgomery County, Autauga County, Elmore County and the City of Montgomery continue to grow and prosper; we believe it is important that we join with government and business leaders in a cooperative effort to implement mutually beneficial planning for the future. It is our hope that you will consider incorporating our recommendations into your communities' land use plans, zoning ordinances, subdivision regulations, codes, and other related documents.
